HISTORIC AND CULTURAL PRESERVATION COMMITTEE

- One unexpired 3-year term. Term expires June 30, 2020.

The Historic and Cultural Preservation Committee (HCPC) is a newly reconstituted committee governed by enabling legislation approved by the City Council. The composition of the HCPC includes specificity to ensure that qualified individuals serve on the committee and that the specialized review of Petaluma's historic resources as the duties of the HCPC establish is being conducted by qualified professionals. Additionally, the HCPC qualifications as established in the enabling legislation meet the minimum requirements for Certified Local Government Status.

Applications are sought from Petaluma residents with professional experience in any of the following fields:

- History
- Curation

- Conservation
- Pre-Historic and Historic Archaeology
- Landscape Architecture

SENIOR ADVISORY COMMITTEE

- Two unexpired 2-year terms. Terms expire June 30, 2018 and June 30, 2019.

The Senior Advisory Committee advises the City on issues and programs for seniors and active adults including the operation of senior facilities.

TRANSIT ADVISORY COMMITTEE

- One unexpired 2-year term. Term expires June 30, 2019.

The Transit Advisory Committee reviews critical issues related to the City's transit operations and the regional bus and rail operations within the City.
