NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Petaluma City Council will hold a public hearing at its regular meeting of November 5, 2018, to allocate unexpended funds as an amendment to 2018-2019 Community Development Block Grant Action Plan.

Consolidated Plan Priorities: In developing the proposed amended Action Plan, the City's objective has been to utilize funding for the benefit of low and moderate-income people and to address the priorities of the 2015-2020 Consolidated Plan. This year 80% of the funds will benefit the target populations and funds will be prioritized for the preservation of affordable housing during FY 2018-2019.
